




Ruapotaka School

New Enrolment Scheme

Overview – what is happening?

The Ministry of Education is developing an enrolment scheme for Ruapotaka School, which will be in effect for the beginning of term 1 in 2022. Having an enrolment scheme in place will ensure the Board of Trustees has a fair and transparent mechanism to manage the roll as it grows. Children that live within this area will have entitlement to enrol at Ruapotaka School. The home zone area is shown on the map on the next page and includes:

Starting at the intersection of Pt England Road and Waddell Avenue, travel south down Waddell Avenue (odd address included) and then east at Anderson Avenue (odd addresses included) until Riverside Avenue. Turn south at Riverside Avenue (197 and below odd, 206 and below even included). Turn west at Tobruk Road (odd addresses included), then south on Tripoli Road (odd addresses included), and then west along Oran Road (odd addresses included). At Court Crescent (61 and above odd included, 74 and above even included), travel slightly southeast and then southwest along the pathway to Coates Crescent (21 and above odd, 54 and above even included). Travel south along Coates Crescent and then west at Hobson Drive (2-6 even included, Martin Place 10-16 included) and continue west along Jellicoe Road (odd addresses included) until turning west along Morrin Road and then north along the railway until Merton Road. At Merton Road, travel east and then continue east along Pt England Road (odd addresses included) until return to the origin.



What does this mean for my family?

If you live in enrolment scheme home area for Ruapotaka School you will be entitled to enrol your child at the school. This entitlement applies to new students starting school, as well as any primary school aged children currently attending another school in the area.

Families who live outside the enrolment scheme home zone of Ruapotaka School do not have entitlement to enrol and could only attend if the Board of Trustees planned to enrol any out of zone students. The enrolment scheme will establish the process for this, and places will only be available if the Board of Trustees considers it has the capacity to allow for this. Further information about whether any out of zone places will be made available will be made later in 2021.

Consultation process and timeline

The Ministry of Education is currently undertaking consultation about the proposed changes and new enrolment schemes. You can have your say by:
